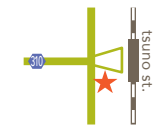

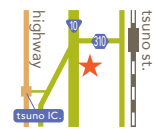

While hiking, you will see rare seasonal flowers and plants that can only be found in Mt.Osuzu.

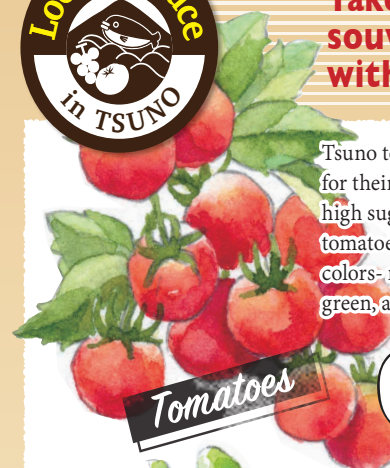


Tsuno Shrine

Peanuts



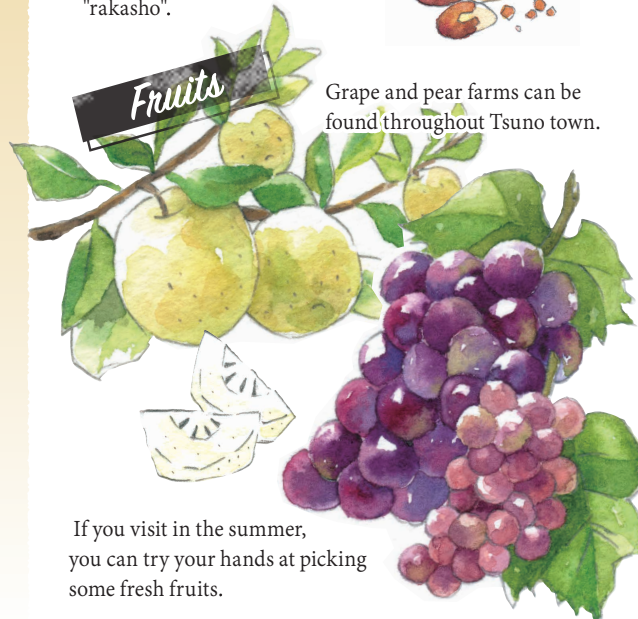
In Tsuno, the locals call them "rakasho".

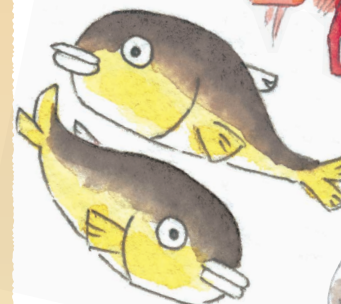
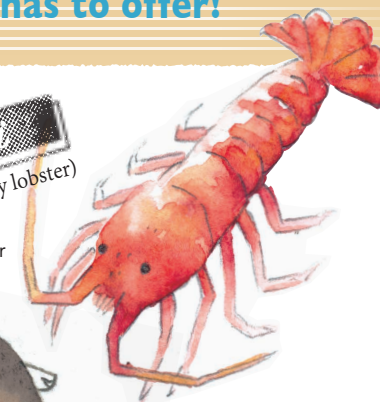
Grape and pear farms can be found throughout Tsuno town.

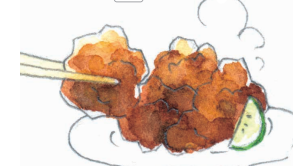

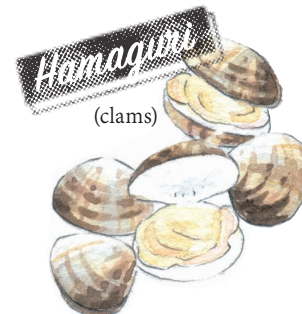

1 Mt. Osuzu
This mountain has an elevation of 1405 meters and is one of Japan's top 200 mountains. There are many rare seasonal plants and flowers that can only be found here.

2 Tsuno Winery
Enjoy panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean while sipping some of the best wines in Japan.

3 Tsuno Shrine
This shrine has a history that goes back over 1100 years. There are cedar trees surrounding the shrine which gives it a peaceful atmosphere.

4 Fudo Waterfall Park
This is the perfect spot to view the cherry blossoms with a waterfall in the background.

5 Tateno walking course
In mid-February, you can walk this 3.3km course among the plum blossoms in full bloom. There are orange trees and small gardens along the way.

6 Akagi Residence
This merchant house was used in the Edo period by feudal lords and other high ranking individuals as a resting spot while traveling. Today it is a private residence.

7 Kappa Statue
A kappa is a mythical creature in Japan that is known to live in rivers and streams. This small stone monument is dedicated to the kappa of Nanuki River in Tsuno Town.

8 Yatogi Waterfall
This waterfall is one of over thirty waterfalls located in Mt. Osuzu and named in the top 100 waterfalls of Japan.

Roadside Station Tsuno

Take a break from driving and drop by here for fresh produce and souvenirs. The parking lot and restrooms are open 24 hours to take a rest.

to Tsuno Station	approx. 5 minutes
to Takachiho	approx. 90 minutes
to Oita Station	approx. 140 minutes
to Kagoshima Station	approx. 150 minutes
